7.3	The first driver over the line in the stand alone KA3 Senior race at the end of the day will be the winner. This will be limited to KA100 motors only. Trophies will be paid for 1 <sup>st</sup> , 2 <sup>nd</sup> and 3 <sup>rd</sup> .

3.1.	Pit Crew with trolleys Will Not be given access to the Circuit during Practice, Qualifying & Racing.
3.2.	Retrieval of Karts is at the discretion of the Clerk of the Course
3.3.	Pit Crew must only enter the Circuit when permitted by the Grid Marshal or the Clerk of the Course and then only if wearing a <b>HIGH VISIBILITY SAFETY VEST</b> on the upper torso.
3.4.	Karts can be retrieved via the out grid gate.
<b>4.</b>	<b>ADDITIONAL VENUE REQUIREMENTS</b>
4.1.	Subject to any applicable laws which may govern the access of animals, including but not limited to guide dogs, no animals are allowed anywhere within the facility.
4.2.	No dumping of Fuel or Tyres, please make your own arrangements.
4.3.	No unlicensed driving of motor vehicles permitted at the Circuit.
4.4.	No motorised scooters, mini bikes, roller blading, skateboards, bicycles and tricycles allowed at the complex during the entire Meeting. Officials may confiscate any such items for the duration of the Meeting.
4.5.	Marquees are not to be erected without consent of the Club.

#### 5. KA3 SENIOR

<b>5.1</b>	At the completion of racing there will be a 21 lap race for the KA3 Senior at the Championship weight of 159kg. This event will be for the KA100 motor only. Grid positions for this race will be done via a random draw. The first driver over the line in this race will be the winner.
<b>5.2</b>	Drivers are permitted to race with new tyres for this one off event if they choose to.
<b>5.3</b>	This one off event will be <b>FREE</b> for competitors to race in.

#### 6. PHIL GOSS MEMORIAL

<b>6.1</b>	The 2019 Phil Goss Memorial will be open to drivers of all classes that are over the age of 40. There will be a selection panel of seven people consisting of the officials of the meeting and LKC members who will vote for the best and fairest driver. The point system will be 5, 3 and 1. The driver with the most points will be awarded the 2019 Phil Goss Memorial. If there is a tie for any position it will refer back to the most 5 points vote, 3 points votes and so on.
